Adaptability is the Key to Survival

- The financial crash of 1929 had a devastating effect on many previously prosperous individuals
- The current financial collapse has left very few persons untouched
- A business person can be ruined by war, natural disasters, or obsolescence

Major Progressions

- Major progressions are determined by the movement and position of the planets each solar day after birth
- One day is roughly equivalent to one year of life
- Each two hours after birth are equal to one month of life
- Each four minutes after birth equal one day of life
- Major progressions carry one-half the power of the natal chart and correspond to the major events and experiences in one's life
- In analyzing major progressions attention is given to the progressed position of the planets, the type of aspect they form, the relative power, harmony, or discord of their natal positions, and any houses they

govern by rulership (look to the sign on the cusp of each house)

- Major progressions are placed in the secondary wheel of the chart
- Progressed planets are "Temporary Stellar Aerials" which attract events/experiences during their period of activity
- In the Hermetic System, progressions are allowed a 1° orb of aspect
- Progressions have specific dates when they enter orb of aspect, become perfect, and leave
- Applying aspects are considered to have more power to attract events than separating aspects
- Progressions can stimulate four or more regions of the chart
- The natal house position of both planets
- The house position of both planets by progression
- The houses each planet co-rules, determined by the sign on the cusp of the house
- "Inner-plane weather consists of astrological vibrations in their infinite variety of combinations. Those mapped by progressed aspects enable planetary vibrations to reach and make active certain groups of thought cells. These thought cells have desires such as were imparted to them when they were formed and as indicated by the aspects of the planets mapping them in the birth chart. Such desires are temporarily altered by the planetary energy reaching them through the innerplane weather mapped by a progressed aspect. And the additional energy thus reaching the thought cells not only gives them the power to influence the individual's

thoughts and behavior, but it also gives them the psychokinetic activity that enables them to attract events of the kind they desire into his life."

Hermetic Astrology works with ten distinct aspects

- Aspects are the angles at which planetary forces join as they radiate towards earth
- Aspects add energy (power) to any chart
- Aspects contribute conditioning energy (harmony or discord)
- The potency of the ten aspects expresses from mild to extremely powerful
- Their conditioning energy can be either harmonious, discordant, or neutral
- Q Venus adds ¹/₄ harmony
- ¹4 Jupiter adds ¹/₂ harmony
- of Mars adds ¹/₄ discord
- $\frac{1}{2}$ Saturn adds $\frac{1}{2}$ discord
- The nature of the progressed aspect contributes in part to type of events attracted
- Neutral: $\pi \parallel \parallel \sigma$
- Harmonious: $\checkmark \star \bigtriangleup$
- Discordant: $\angle \Box \Box \circ^{\circ}$

Importance of Event Depends Upon Intensity of Thought-Cell Activity

• "In predicting what events will be attracted into the life at a given time, therefore, the first thing to do is to consider the normal composition and activity of the thought-cells within the compartment of the astral body affected. Then consider the volume, type, and harmony or discord of the energy added to the stellar cells within the compartment, and estimate not merely the amount of activity which will result from this new energy supply, but also how the new energy supply modifies or accentuates their normal feeling of harmony or discord."

- The relative conditioning energy of a planet in the natal chart contributes to its ability to attract pleasurable or painful experiences by progression
- Each progressed aspect attracts its own type of event
- Harmonious and discordant progressed aspects do not annul each other – they attract different events
- The house cusp positions of the natal chart remain constant (the only cusps we progress are the Asc. and MC.)
- Planets progress forward or backward (if retrograde) into the houses impacting these departments of life

Progressed aspects can stimulate four or more regions of the chart

- The natal house position of both planets
- The house position of both planets by progression
- The houses each planet co-rules, determined by the sign on the cusp of the house
- We look to the houses activated by progressions to determine what areas of life will be stimulated
- Progressions can be listed chronologically according to the date that aspects entered orb
- Based on a one degree orb, the progression report includes the date a planet enters aspect

- The date the aspect becomes exact or perfect
- The date it leaves orb of aspect
- The first symbol in the series indicates the planet forming the aspect by progression
- The second symbol is the aspect
- The third symbol is the planet with which the aspect is being formed
- The letter "r" following the planet indicate that it is "radical" or a planet in the natal chart
- The letter "p" indicates that it is a "progressed" planet


The Trinity of Wealth

- The Trinity of Wealth is comprised of houses 2, 6, and 10
- <u>Financial Success</u>: the favorable or prosperous termination of attempts or endeavors; the attainment of wealth, position, honors, or the like: a successful performance or achievement.
- ProsperityProsperity is the state of flourishing, thriving, success, or good fortune. Prosperity often encompasses wealth but also includes others factors which are independent of wealth to varying degrees, such as happiness and health
- Experiences are Attracted from Within
- Why is it that some persons go into business for themselves and fail, while others succeed?
- Why does one person succeed in being self-employed while another must work for others?
- Why does one person succeed at real estate while another loses their home to foreclosure?

- Why does one person win big in the stock market while another loses his shirt every time he speculates?
- Why do some persons thrive in business partnerships while others are brought to their ruin through the influence of a partner?
- "The explanation of this lies in the extra-physical power of the thoughtcells within man's astral body. These thought-cells have been built by experiences before human birth. These experiences, and experiences after human birth, have endowed them with energy and given them desires. They work from the inner plane with such energy as they can acquire to bring into the life the conditions and events, including abundance or poverty of money, that they desire."

Four Factors of Making Money

- Determine activity of the 2nd house indicated by planetary ruler(s) and aspects
- Note the prominence of Jupiter (attracts wealth), Saturn (keeps it) and Mars (squanders it)
- 10th house (credit) and 8th house (debts)
- Influence of Sun (Gold = large bills) and Moon (Silver = small change)
- "The most powerful thought-cells in the finer body to influence money are those mapped by the planet ruling the second house of the birth chart. When this planet is known, every effort should be made to add to its harmony by associating thoughts, feelings and actions of pleasure that correspond to it with thoughts of money. Each planet rules a given type of thought, and the type of thoughts ruled by the planet governing the second house should be built up both in power and in harmony through appropriate thoughts, feelings and actions."

- Look at your 2nd house, do you have any planets in the house? What are they?
- What is the sign ruling the cusp of your 2nd house? What planet or planets rule that sign? In what sign and what house are they located in your chart?
- Look at your astrodyne report. What is the relative power and harmony of your 2nd house?
- How do these above factors impact your habits with attracting, saving, and spending money?
- To make money, there must be a demand for your products or services. Analyze the demand
- To gain money we must exchange goods or services that other people desire so that they are willing to part with their money for it
- The more reasonably priced your goods and services are the more likely others will exchange money for them
- In these hard financial times it is especially important to keep in mind that others will only part with their money for food, clothing, shelter, or something highly pleasurable
- "The first thing that should be thoroughly understood is that one cannot make money from those things that astrologically correspond to discordant groups of thought-cells within his astral body. A careful study of the birth chart will reveal which thought-cells were discordant at birth, and probably remain so unless a systematic effort has been made to change them. To make money from the things indicated by

the astrological factors mapping these thought-cells would require that the desires of these thought-cells should be reconditioned. It is possible, within limits, to do this, but it usually is far more profitable to devote the energy among those things toward which from birth there have been powerful and harmonious thought-cell desires."

- Money is not easily gained through activities that astrologically correspond to discordant thoughts cells in one's astral body
- To make money from those areas represented by discordant thought cells they must first be reconditioned
- It is easier and more profitable to devote energy to making money from activities where there are powerful and harmonious thought cells
- Your best wealth-attracting resource = your best (most harmonious) planet, sign, house
- Your greatest wealth repelling resource = your worst (most discordant) planet, sign, house
- In making money, never lose sight of the other person's point of view
- Remember other people are your source of money
- Merely wanting someone to pay for your goods and services is not sufficient to make them want to do so
- People will only part with their money if they are getting what they want
- They will part with their money more readily if they like you

• To make money you must appeal to the desire fulfillment of those who have money

MANNER IN WHICH MONEY IS GAINED BY HOUSE

- 1st Capitalize on personality and appearance
- 2nd Banking, finances, buying and selling
- 3rd Transportation, communications, and writing
- 4th Real-estate, rentals, building, architecture, house wares, and hotels
- 5th Stocks, bonds, speculation, children's services, arts and entertainment
- 6th Food service and preparation, health or medical
- 7th Gain through meeting the public, agent, counselor
- 8th Gifts, legacies, insurance and investments
- 9th Teaching, lecturing, publishing or travel
- 10th Business, management, politics
- 11th Groups, friends, networking and event-planning
- 12th Hospitals, retreats, prisons, zoos, sanctuaries, investigative work
- "To the extent the thought-cell group is powerfully discordant will loss of wealth occur. But to the extent the thought-cell group is powerfully harmonious in its desires, wealth will be forthcoming. This is the law.

Attracting Wealth by Progression

- Q Venus and 4 Jupiter are known as the "benefics" and are natural wealth-builders in a chart
- Progressions involving \mathcal{Q} Venus attract gratuities or gifts
- Progressions involving ¹4 Jupiter can attract abundance
- Harmonious progressions (∠ ★ △) involving the ruler or rulers of the second house stimulate periods of financial growth
- Progressions involving ♂ Mars attract expenditures and strife
- Progressions involving [†] Saturn tend towards restrictions and poverty
- Discordant progressions (∠ □ □ o^o) involving the ruler or rulers of the second house stimulate periods of financial difficulties
- Neutral progressions (⊼ || ∜ σ) involving the ruler or rulers of the second house indicate periods of opportunity which are colored by the conditioning energy of the planets involved

6th House – Employment

- Progressions involving the Sixth House stimulate activity in our employment, service, work-place, colleagues, coworkers, employees, tenants, diet, nutrition, food, illness, small pets.
- The planet or planets governing the 6th house in a natal chart indicate our attitudes and expectations towards work and the type of relationships we tend to have with colleagues and coworkers.
- If the 6th house is overall harmonious we tend to have greater ease in attracting employment

- A discordant 6th house requires that one must exert greater effort to gain employment
- Attracting Employment by Progression
- The "benefics," ♀ Venus and ↓ Jupiter attract favorable employment opportunities
- Harmonious progressions (∠ × △) involving the ruler or rulers of the sixth house stimulate positive periods opportunity
- Progressions involving the "malefics" ♂ Mars and [†] Saturn stimulate difficulties around gaining employment
- Discordant progressions (∠ □ □ o^o) involving the ruler or rulers of the sixth house stimulate periods of employment obstacle or where loss of employment can take place
- Neutral progressions (\(\pi\) || \$\\$\(\sigma\) o) involving the ruler or rulers of the sixth house indicate periods of activity which are colored by the conditioning energy of the planets involved in the aspect

10th House

- Progressions involving the Tenth House stimulate one's career, vocation, professional life, honor, reputation, credit, public standing, status, awards, business, authority figures, bosses, and superiors
- <u>Career</u>: an occupation or profession, esp. one requiring special training, followed as one's lifework; A person's progress or general course of action through life or through a phase of life, as in some profession or undertaking; success in a profession, occupation, etc.
- <u>Vocation</u>: a particular occupation, business, or profession; calling; a

strong impulse or inclination to follow a particular activity or career.

- <u>Avocation</u>: something a person does in addition to a principal occupation, esp. for pleasure; hobby.
- "Any progressed aspect involving the M.C. affects the honor, the business and the publicity."

- Factors of Business Success
- The 10th house maps those thought cells associated with business, honor and reputation. It indicates the conditions a person meets which influence his/her credit and reputation regardless of the vocation s/he chooses
- The prominence and harmony of the Sun will determine whether or not s/he will succeed in business for him/herself
- In some charts the prominence and harmony of the MC will determine whether or not s/he will succeed in business for him/herself
- Also note the strength and harmony of the business planets Jupiter and Saturn
- Vocational selection is based on helping the individual to express his or her ability through the areas of greatest harmony
- In judging vocation using the astrological method we look for expression of ability, dominant temperament and, aptitude through avenues of personal harmony.

JUDGING THE ABILITY

- Prominent planets represent ability
- Look to temperament and disposition for expression (Dominant planet, 1st house, mentality = Moon and

Mercury, and Sun sign, Dominant element)

• Choose an environment which corresponds with the area of greatest harmony in the chart. Analyze planets, signs, houses and aspects for direction






