 - ♃ **Jupiter**
- Jupiter, the fifth planet from the Sun is the largest of the planets
- Jupiter is the third brightest object in the night sky after the Moon and Venus
- Jupiter is 2 ½ times as massive as all other planets in our solar system combined
- Along with Saturn, Uranus, and Neptune, Jupiter is classified as a “gas giant”
- Jupiter takes 4,334.50 days (11.86 years) to pass through the entire zodiac or 361 days to go through one sign
 - ♃ **Jupiter – Mythology**
- The Ancient Egyptians referred to Jupiter as Amun the “King of the gods”
- To the Sumerians Jupiter was known as Marduk, lord of water, vegetation and magic who wrested the “Tablets of Destiny” from the hands of his dying enemy
- In mythology Zeus was chief among the gods and would change his shape in order to consort among the mortals. His symbols were the thunderbolt, eagle, bull, and oak
- The Sculptor Phidias created a 40 foot tall image of Zeus at Olympia around 435 BC, this was perhaps the most famous statues of the god of heaven and thunder in the ancient world
- Thor was the Old Norse god of thunder and lightning
- He destroyed the Midgard Serpent, but after taking only nine steps he fell dead from its poison
- Thursday or Thor’s day is the day ruled by Jupiter
- In Latin it is *Jovis Dies*, which became in Italian *Giovedì*, in French *jeudi* in Spanish *Jueves*, Romanian *Joi*, and in Catalan *dijous*
- King of gods and lord of heaven, Indra, the Hindu equivalent of Jupiter rides his mount Airavata
- Like his western counterpart he carries the thunderbolt scepter known as the vajra
- Brihaspati the deity of religion and piety is another name for Jupiter as is the term Guru, meaning teacher
 - ♃
- *“Jupiter is symbolized by the cross of matter surmounted by the crescent of soul. This is just the reverse of the Saturnine emblem, so we need not be surprised that in practical astrology Jupiter expresses qualities the antithesis of those expressed by Saturn. Feeling preponderates, and gives rise to genial warmth, noble aspirations, generosity, expansion, and good will toward all. Those dominated by Jupiter often became philanthropists, or take an active part in work having for its object social welfare and moral uplift. Lovers of fair play and benevolence, it is their constant delight to make others happy. The magnanimity of the Greek Jove and the Scandinavian Thor, and the Jupiter quality of giving, are well expressed as arising from soul emotion by the dominant crescent.*

- **♃ Jupiter Personality**

- “The Jupiter person gravitates to the professions, and also has ability to sell on account of his jovial personality. Menial employment is beneath his dignity, and he chafes under much restraint. He does well, however, at merchandising. His best quality is BENEVOLENCE.
- His worst quality is CONCEIT. He always has a good opinion of himself. And he should early realize that Deity permitted others than himself also to have correct opinions, and that true charity demands that he give them due consideration. The thoughts ruled by this planet are called the RELIGIOUS thoughts.

- **♃ Alchemical Tin/Religious Urges**

- “Thinking about religion, good cheer, benevolence, joviality, and faith and confidence in Deity brings into the life such conditions as come through abundance, patronage, and the favors of those who have plenty of money and worldly goods. Discordant thoughts of this type are responsible for extravagance, for paying too great a price for purchases and for diseases which arise from an over abundance of something such as some acidosis, one type of diabetes, biliousness, catarrh, auto-intoxication, carbuncles and fatty tumors.”

- **Negative Jupiter Traits**
- Affected, boisterous, conceited, exaggerative, excessive, extravagant, flamboyant, grandiose, haughty, holier-than-thou, lavish, ostentatious, overly-generous, pompous, pretentious, sanctimonious, self-righteous, smug, showy, snooty, stuck-up, superior, wasteful

- **Jupiter Occupations**
- Backer, banker, benefactor, business professional, celebrant, cheerleader, cleric, coach, comedian, contributor, counselor, devotee, donor, enthusiast, entrepreneur, financier, guarantor, guide, guru, humanitarian, instructor, investor, judge, lawyer, marketer, minister, patron, philanthropist, priest, rabbi, ritual specialist, salesman, sponsor, supporter, trainer, trustee, venture capitalist

- **JUPITER:** The arterial blood stream of the body and the financial system of society are expressions of the thought-cells ruled by Jupiter. These thought-cells which so powerfully influence good will and abundance have been organized in lower forms of life through experiences with obedience to the ruling authority, such as the parents, and looking to such higher power for guidance, protection and the satisfaction of want. Because their chief expression relates to religious devotion they are called the RELIGIOUS thought-cells. Aspects to Jupiter affect through abundance, optimism and joviality. To the extent the thought-cells mapped by Jupiter are active is the life influenced by thoughts of benevolence, veneration, hope,

devotion, selling, good will or generosity.

- When Jupiter is prominent in the birth chart it denotes one who feels menial employment is beneath his dignity. As a consequence he seeks a profession, engages in merchandising, or becomes a salesman. His joviality and ability to gain patronage and favors through the good will he radiates are valuable assets.
- When prominent and afflicted, the good opinion he has of himself tends to develop CONCEIT. The earlier he recognizes that Deity has permitted others than himself also to have correct opinions, and that he therefore should be charitable toward those opinions, the sooner he will begin to realize the feeling of BENEVOLENCE which he so strongly craves.

The Trine Aspect Δ

- The Trine is a **LUCK** Compound
- The Trine is formed when two planets are 120 degrees or four signs apart in zodiacal longitude
- This is the most favorable aspect. A trine signifies abilities, favors, and opportunities which come easily and spontaneously
- Under Trine aspects we must cultivate gratitude and exert ourselves in the areas in which we'd like to experience growth

♃ Jupiter Signs

- The planet Jupiter takes almost 12 years to make a complete cycle through the Zodiac, spending approximately 1 year in each sign
- The sign of the zodiac in which the Jupiter falls in the birth-chart is

considered to represent the religious, ethical, and benevolent nature of the individual

- **Jupiter in Aries**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing from the I Am attitude, faith should be broadened to include the opinions and abilities of others as well as one's own.
- **Jupiter in Taurus**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing from the I Have attitude, there should be faith in spiritual things rather than in the power of money to buy.
- **Jupiter in Gemini**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing from the I Think attitude, faith should be cultivated in carefully ascertained facts rather than in voluble statements.
- **Jupiter in Cancer**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing from the I Feel attitude, faith should be placed in the impressions rather than in the external appearance of things.
- **Jupiter in Leo**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing from the I Will attitude, faith should be cultivated in the willingness of others to respond to kindness rather than in the power to dominate.
- **Jupiter in Virgo**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing from the I Analyze attitude, faith should be placed in the good qualities of others rather than in the power of their weaknesses to cause difficulty.
- **Jupiter in Libra**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing from the I Balance attitude, faith should be placed in justice and firmness rather than in the plaudits of others.
- **Jupiter in Scorpio**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing from the I Desire attitude, faith should be placed in forthright resourcefulness rather than in hidden action and cunning.
- **Jupiter in Sagittarius**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing from the I See attitude, faith should be placed in prayer and devotion rather than in impulse and enthusiasm.
- **Jupiter in Capricorn**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing from the I Use attitude, faith should be cultivated in gaining honors through benefiting society rather than through deceit.
- **Jupiter in Aquarius**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing from the I Know attitude, faith should be placed in facts and altruism rather than in theories and argument.
- **Jupiter in Pisces**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing from the I Believe attitude, faith should be cultivated that all will work out to advantage rather than that difficulties will prove serious.

- **♃ Jupiter in the Houses**
- The house in which the Jupiter falls in the birth-chart is said to be subject to Abundance
- The house position of the Jupiter strongly indicates the area of life through which the individual seeks to express benevolence and optimism and enjoys opportunities for good-will from others
- “Whatever house is occupied by Jupiter indicates a section of the life in which there is plenty. Jupiter withholds not the things denoted by the house he occupies. When severely afflicted by aspects much difficulty may arise over the things denoted by this house, but in some manner a way will be found to pull through with head above water, even though in extreme cases failure may be escaped only by a hair’s breadth.... The department of life ruled by the house occupied by Jupiter is subject to **Abundance**.”

- **Jupiter in First House**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing through the personality, salesmanship and joviality are shown. These should be used to benefit all rather than to indulge self.
- **Jupiter in Second House**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing through possessions, financial abundance is shown. Using it for philanthropic purposes will bring greatest satisfaction.
- **Jupiter in Third House** —With the Religious thought-cells expressing through education, benefit from travel and relatives is shown. The desire for clear thinking and study should be cultivated.
- **Jupiter in Fourth House**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing through the home, abundance in the home is shown. Discrimination should be cultivated relative to home and domestic life.
- **Jupiter in Fifth House**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing through pleasure, fortune in speculation and games of chance is shown. Discrimination should be cultivated in reference to all pleasures.
- **Jupiter in Sixth House**—With the Jupiter thought-cells expressing through work, excellent service from employees is shown. Taste for a well balanced diet rather than for rich foods should be cultivated.
- **Jupiter in Seventh House**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing through partnership, wealth or other benefits through marriage is shown. Discrimination in selecting a partner should be cultivated.
- **Jupiter in Eighth House**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing through inheritance, abundance through gifts and inheritance is shown. Business can safely be run on a credit basis.
- **Jupiter in Ninth House**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing through philosophy, benefit through publishing, religion or travel is shown. Discrimination in religion and expressing opinions should be cultivated.
- **Jupiter in Tenth House**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing through honor, honors and high credit are shown. Discrimination in all business transactions should be cultivated.

- **Jupiter in Eleventh House**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing through friends, friends of wealth, and friends who will go a long way to help, are shown. Discrimination in the selection of friends and associates should be cultivated.
- **Jupiter in Twelfth House**—With the Religious thought-cells expressing through disappointment, benefit rather than injury from the efforts of secret enemies is shown. Discrimination should be cultivated in the effort to alleviate the distress of others.
