- Eighth planet from the Sun, Neptune is named for the Roman god of the sea
- The fourth-largest planet by diameter and the third-largest by mass. Neptune is 17 times the mass of Earth and is slightly more massive than its near-twin Uranus
- Like the other Jovian planets (Jupiter, Saturn and Uranus) Neptune is a "Gas Giant"
- Neptune was discovered in 1846 by Urbain le Verrier, John Couch Adams, and Johann Galle while in conjunction with Saturn in the sign of Aquarius
- Neptune is the first planet discovered by mathematical prediction based on perturbations in the orbit of Uranus
- Neptune requires 60,190 days (165 years) to make a complete circle through the zodiac
- Neptune spends 14 years in each sign
- The placement of Neptune in the zodiac refers to generational qualities

• **W** Neptune – Mythology

- To the ancient Greeks, Poseidon (Neptune) was the god of both horses and the sea
- With one strike of his trident, the contemporary symbol for the planet Neptune, he could cause earthquakes, shipwrecks, and drowning
- Greek sailors would sometimes propitiate Poseidon by drowning horses as a sacrifice, before heading out to sea.
- Poseidon, born to Kronos and Rhea, narrowly escaped the fate of his other siblings of being cannibalized by his father
- When the world was divided into three parts among the gods, Hades received the underworld, Zeus the sky, and Poseidon the sea
- Neptune is generally pictured with Amphrite, his wife and queen

- Yamm was the Egyptian god of the sea who placed exorbitant demands for tribute from the other deities
- He was eventually thwarted by the goddess Astarte
- The Norse god of the sea was known as [†]gir
- the gir lives in a hall where the beer pours itself
- He was famous for giving elaborate parties for the other gods


