Detailed Chart Analysis – Part 1

What you can't tell from looking at a birth chart:

- Evolutionary level
- Influence of genetic factors
- Social Status, greatness, etc. (Mahatma Gandhi, Abraham Lincoln)

What every chart reading should contain

Preliminaries

- If you are writing out the chart analysis, you will by now have summarized the chart using the first six steps.
- Determine Dominant Planet
 - Usually angular house
 - Most powerfully aspected
 - Look at the astrodynes
- Note the decanate (ten degree section of zodiac) occupied by the Sun, Moon, Ascendant,
 Mercury & Dominant Planet

- These decanates are extremely useful in determining the person's mission in life and can be a valuable aid to them. Usually one is predominant, but all four (Sun, Moon, Asc & Dominant Planet) can be manifest in the life.

With regard to the Decanates, Zain says that:

- As the Sun qualities mapped by the Sun in the birth chart being the most persistent and deep seated, Zain refers to the decanate containing the Sun in the chart is the decanate in which the INDIVIDUALITY is polarized.
- The factors that indicate the type of experience most easily received and assimilated by the unconscious mind, and that thus determine the general quality of the mental processes, are shown in the birth chart by the decanate occupied by the Moon. While every planet and aspect in the chart represents definite mental factors and relationships, Zain says that the MENTALITY is polarized in the decanate occupied by the Moon.

- As the Ascendant is the interface between the physical body and the unconscious mind (soul), the decanate in which we find the Ascendant relates to the PERSONALITY.

Physical Appearance, Temperament, Disposition and Mental Ability

Meaning of the phrase "is mapped by"

Physical Appearance (in order of importance in judging)

See tables of physical description by sign and planet in CS8 *Horary Astrology* (Zain), Chapter 3, "Doctrine of Horary Astrology".

- 1. Planets in the first house and the sign on the Ascendant
 - a. Usually the planet closest to the cusp if several planets in 1st
 - b. Consider planets in the 12th that are conjunction the Asc (within 15 degrees or so)
 - c. The more numerous the planets in the 1st and/or conjunction Asc, the smaller, more compact the body.
- 2. The ruler of the sign on the Asc
 - a. If there is a planet in the 1st, the planet ruling the sign on the Asc is considered the coruler.
 - b. If there is no planet in the 1st or with 15 degrees of the Asc, the planet ruling the sign on the Asc is considered the chief ruler of the personality.
- 3. Sun sign (less important)
- 4. Dominant planet may stamp it's influence on the

Temperament & Disposition (in order of importance)

- 1. Dominant planet most energy in the chart
- 2. Rising sign and decanate and planets in the $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ house
 - a. Give precedence to planets in, or within 15 degrees of, the 1st house
 - b. Aspects to the chief ruler of the personality indicate temperamental traits
- 3. Mentality Moon sign
- 4. Sun sign

Note the best and worst qualities of dominant planet and chief ruler of personality.

Factors Which Indicate Overall Character (more dominant, deep seated traits).

Definition of "character"...

- 1. Dominant Planet
- 2. Sun sign
- 3. The Moon sign which governs the Mentality.
- 4. Rising sign and planet

Factors Which Indicate Mental Ability

- 1. The method by which thoughts are expressed is mapped by Mercury.
- 2. Those things which are most easily assimilated by the unconscious mind is mapped by the Moon and the sign and house which it occupies.
- 3. Every aspect to the Moon and Mercury, harmonious or discordant, increases mental capacity and ability.

Any planet in the chart that is unusually prominent ...

can be turned into an asset by training it to express its best qualities. (See chart of Best and Worst qualities.)
