
The Horoscope Spread



- (Card I) The physical body, appearance, health, personality, temperament, selfimage, self-consciousness, personal interests and desires.
- 2. (Card 12) Possessions, finances and values.
- 3. (Card 8) Private thoughts, mental interests, attitudes, studies, communications, writing, telephone calls, short trips, siblings, neighbors & neighborhood.
- (Card 4) Home, father, real-estate, domestic matters, early childhood, conditions at the end of life, beginnings & endings.
- (Card II) Romance, pleasures, love-affairs, sex, creativity, entertainment, children, gambling & speculation.
- (Card 7) Work, service, work-place, colleagues, coworkers, employees, tenants, diet, nutrition, food, illness, small pets.
- 7. (Card 3) Marriage, partnerships, allies, opponents, competitors, the public.
- 8. (Card 10) Death, the end of things, spirit world, metaphysics, inheritances, legacies, other people's resources, partner's money, credit & debts.
- 9. (Card 6) Religion, philosophy, the higher mind, higher education, publicly expressed

- opinions, teaching, advertising, publishing, travel, international matters, import/export.
- 10. (Card 2) Reputation, status, honor, awards, business, career, bosses, superiors, mother.
- (Card 9) Friends, acquaintances, associations, groups, clubs, organizations, hopes & wishes, social objectives, humanitarian goals.
- 12. (Card 5) Secrets, mysteries, detective work, sorrows, disappointments, hidden enemies, places of confinement, prisons, jails, asylums, monasteries, ashrams, zoos, hospitals, social work, welfare, the occult, unseen psychic forces.

The Horoscope Spread

To use the diagram as a tarot spread the cards are dealt one by one upon the houses of the horoscope in the order indicated by the numbers in the diagram. The reading is used to foretell the near future of every department of life of the one making the consultation. The card falling upon any house of the chart will reveal the fortune of those things ruled by that house astrologically. The cards should be turned over only as read.

Trine I—6—II is the trine of life (houses I, 5, & 6). Ist house relates to personal things and health. The 5th house is the life of posterity, ruling children, love affairs, pleasures, and speculation.

The 9th house is the life of the mind, governing philosophy, publishing, and travel. The 5th house is the life of posterity, ruling children, love affairs, pleasures, and speculation.

Trine 2—7—12 is the trine of power (houses 2, 6, & 10). The 2nd house is the power of wealth, ruling cash and personal property. The 6th house is the power given by environment, governing sickness, servants, and labor.

The 10th house is the power to attract honor and authority, ruling business, credit, and reputation.

Trine3—8—9 is the social trine (houses 3, 7, & II). The 3rd house is the society of kindred and thoughts, governing brethren, studies, writing, and short journeys. The 7th house is the society of partners, and rules the husband or wife, open enemies, and law suits. The IIth house is the society of associates, ruling friends and hopes.

Trine 4—10—5 (houses 4, 8, & 12)is the trine of concealed things. The 4th house is the environment more or less concealed, ruling the home, real estate, and the end of life. The 8th house is the concealed things of death and fatality, ruling legacies and the partner's money. The 12th house is the concealed afflictions, governing disappointments, restrictions, and secret enemies.
