

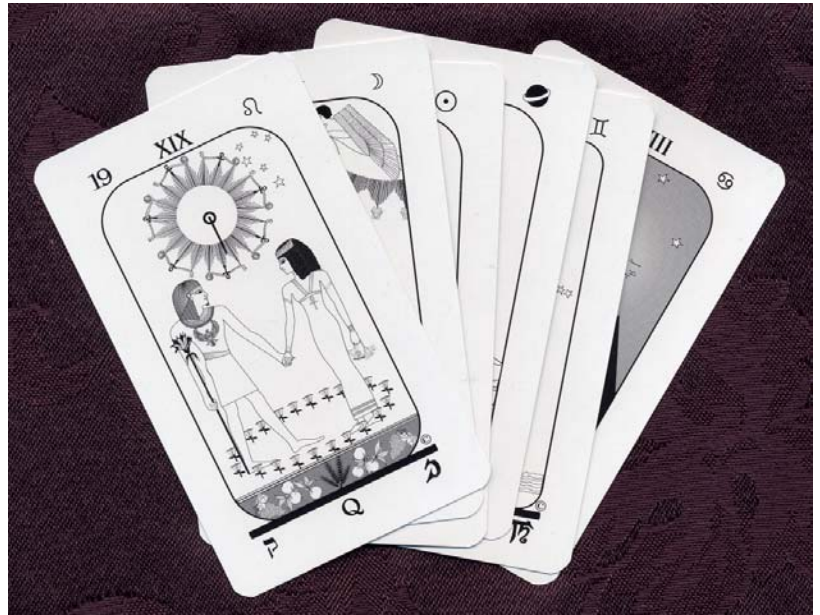

He has been featured in *Who's Who in America*, *LA Inside Out*, and *Faces of Faith*. Christopher has been involved with astrology and tarot studies since 1968 and has maintained a professional practice since 1977. His astrological background is with the Church of Light in which he is certified as a Hermetician and Ordained Minister. He has served on the board of Directors of the Church of Light since 1978 in varying capacities as president, vice-president, and corporate secretary. Christopher has lectured extensively both internationally and throughout the US. He has held memberships with the Association for Astrological Networking, American Federation of Astrologers, and Professional Astrologers Incorporated.
